President's Corner

The meeting on December 6 was focused on establishing the 2024 budget. I would like to highlight the key points:

- We reviewed the past history of the accounts and budgets. Some monies were allocated incorrectly, but these accounting errors have been rectified and all accounts are accurate and in order.
- The Bay Tree operating account was carrying approximately \$8,000 in excess funds. These monies will remain in the operating account should expenses exceed our proposed budget
- Due to increases primarily in insurance premiums and the cost of labor and materials, Mike McCarthy made the following recommendations to the budget and all Board members approved:
 - ✓ An increase of \$88/month to accommodate increases in costs in the operating budget
 - ✓ An increase of \$22/month to accommodate anticipated expenditures related to the reserves
 - \checkmark As a result, there will be an increase of \$330/quarter to the HOA fees in 2024
- The 2024 Annual Meeting is scheduled for January 11th, 2024 at 6:30pm at the Clubhouse. Any neighbors interested in running for the 2024 Board are asked to submit a notice to intent by December 22nd.

Ria Ludlow will be replacing Tara Fleming on the Buildings & Grounds Committee. Tara has concerns about meeting the time required to serve on this committee and I am very pleased that Ria will be stepping in.

Many thanks to our neighbors Ron and Marti Paul, Billy McCrystal and Mike Jenkins for their efforts with the pool, the wetland area and the grates. Your time and donations have saved Bay Tree funds and improved the community immensely. I also want to thank all the neighbors who put up the holiday decorations making our community look so festive! All efforts are most appreciated.
